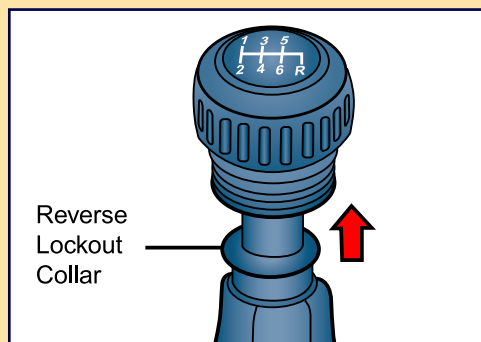


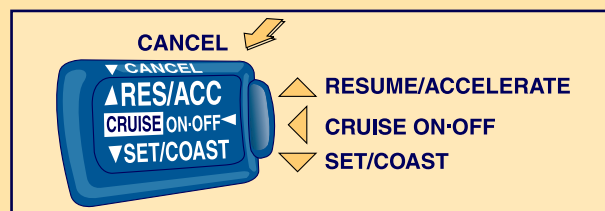
Manual Transmission



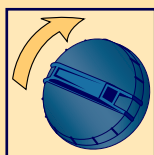
For 6-Speed manual transmission models (if equipped), lift collar tab to shift into reverse.

Refer to Owner's Manual (section 2) for detailed information.

Cruise Control



Fuel Cap

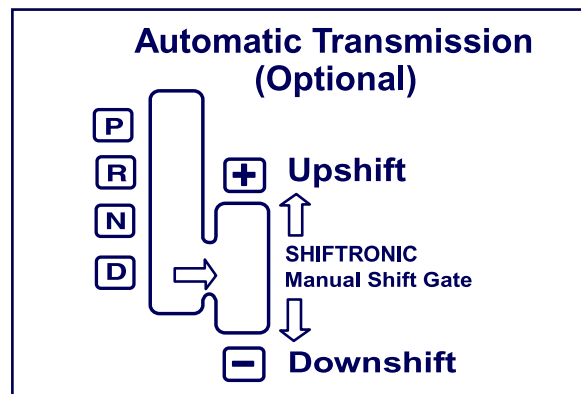


After adding fuel, always reinstall the fuel cap fully and make sure it clicks at least 3 times. Failure to do this may result in the "Check Engine Light" illuminating.

Tire Inflation

Check tire pressure at least once a month when the tires are cold. Refer to the tire pressure label located on the driver side center pillar outer panel for correct pressure.

Automatic Transmission



To select automatic mode, shift to **D**.

To select **SHIFTRONIC™** mode move the shift lever right to the manual shift gate from the D (Drive) position. The instrument cluster displays the selected forward gear.

Refer to the Owner's Manual (section 2) for detailed information.

Basic Safety Precautions

- Whenever operating the vehicle, make sure that you and your occupants are properly wearing your seat belts.
- Small children should always ride in the rear seat in the appropriate child restraint system (see Owner's Manual for child safety details).
- Never place children under thirteen years old in the front seats to avoid injury that may result from air bag deployment.
- Always refer to the Owner's Manual for complete safety precaution information.

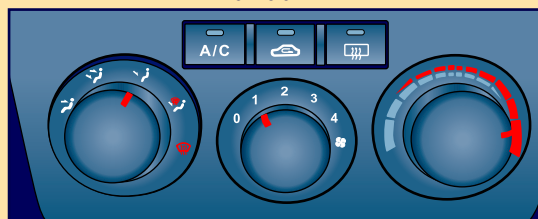

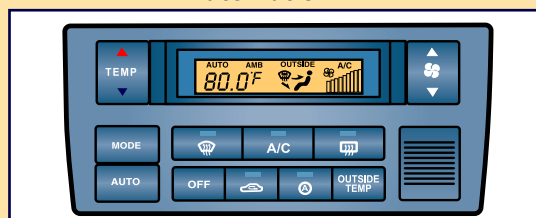

Windshield Defogging

Manual A/C



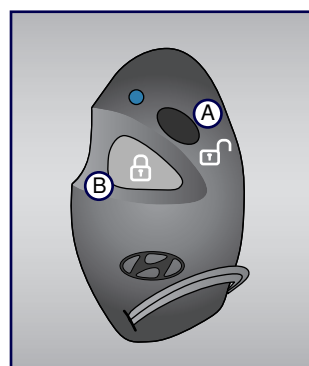
Automatic A/C



To remove fog or frost on the windshield:

- Set the airflow control to the defrost () position. (The A/C will turn on automatically and "Fresh" mode will be activated.)
- Set the temperature control to the desired setting
- Set the fan speed control to position "3" or "4".

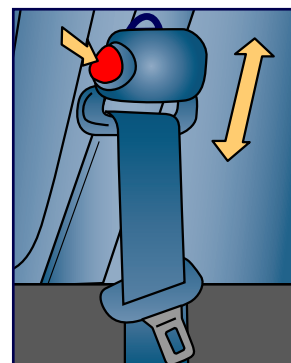
Keyless Remote



Keyless Remote and Locks (if equipped)

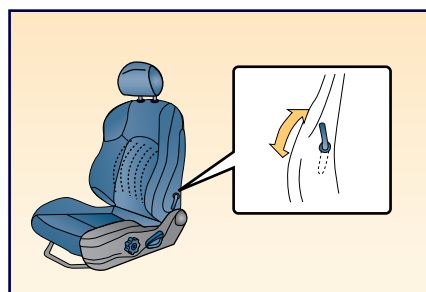
- Press **UNLOCK** on the transmitter to disarm and unlock the driver's door. Press **UNLOCK** again within 4 seconds to unlock all the doors.
- Press **LOCK** on the transmitter to lock all the doors and arm the alarm. Press **LOCK** again within 4 seconds to hear a confirmation chirp.

Height Adjustable Front Seat Shoulder Belt



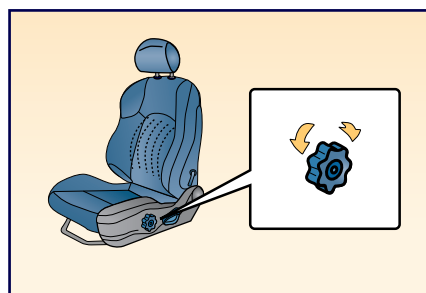
- Push anchor upwards to raise the height adjuster.
- Push anchor downward while pressing the height adjuster button to lower.

Seats



Lumbar Support:

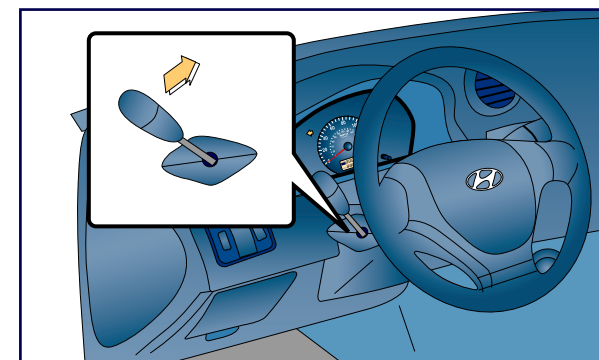
To adjust the lumbar support, move the lever on the outboard or left side of the seat to the desired position.



Seat Cushion Height Adjustment (Driver's Seat Only) (if installed):

To raise or lower the front part of the seat cushion, turn the knob forward or rearward.

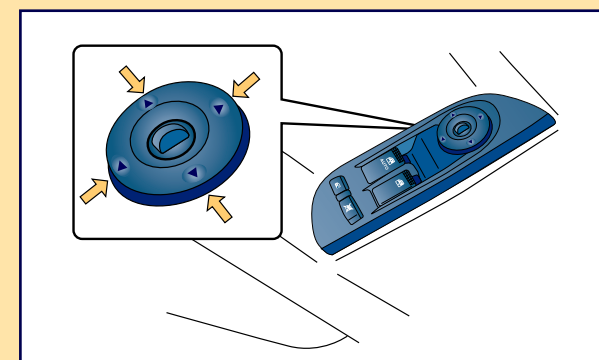
Tilt Steering Wheel



To adjust the steering wheel tilt, pull the lock lever and raise or lower the steering wheel to a comfortable position. Release the lock lever to maintain desired setting.

Note: Do not attempt to adjust the steering wheel while driving.

Mirrors

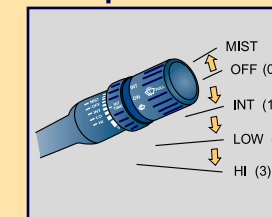


1. Move the select switch to the right or left to activate the corresponding door mirror.
2. Adjust the mirror angle by depressing the appropriate perimeter switch as illustrated.
3. Place the selecting switch in the middle position to deactivate the perimeter switch.

Note: The outside rearview mirror heaters work when the rear window defroster is turned on.

Windshield Wiper Washer

Wiper Modes

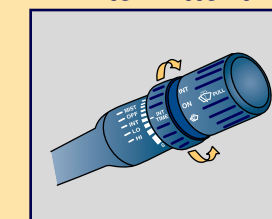


Move the right switch lever up or down to select the following wiper operation modes.

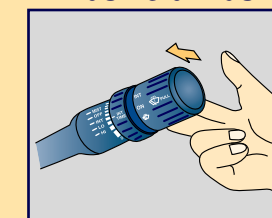
- (Up) Mist
- (0) OFF
- (1) Intermittent*
- (2) Low-speed
- (3) High-speed

* Adjuster barrel controls intermittent interval

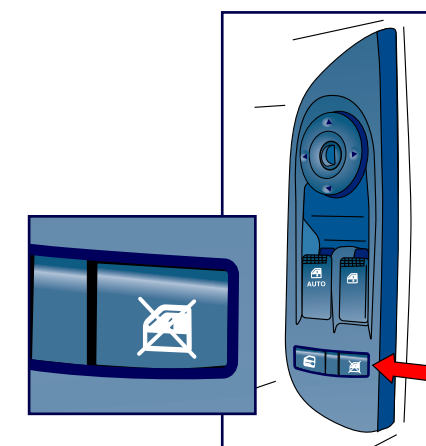

Windshield Washer



Power Window Lock



Pressing the lock switch deactivates all of the power window switches except for the driver's window.
