# Smartphone Integration

Android Auto & Apple CarPlay

- 1 Connect a USB cable from your phone to the vehicle's USB slot.

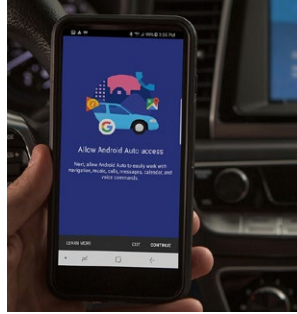

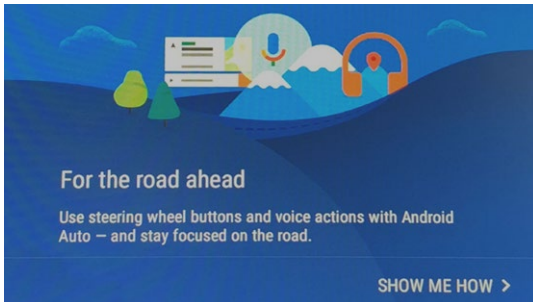

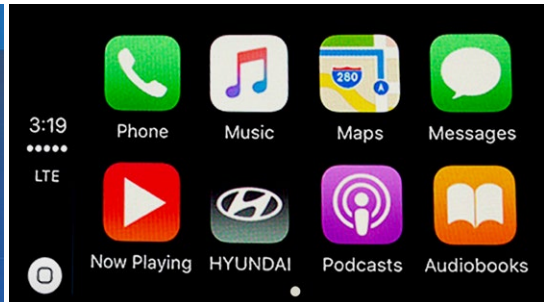


- 3 Enjoy using the applications displayed on your vehicle's multimedia screen.

# Phone Pairing



2018 KONA

Navigation and Display Audio

- 1 The vehicle's shifter must be in **PARK**.

Then press the **SETUP** button.



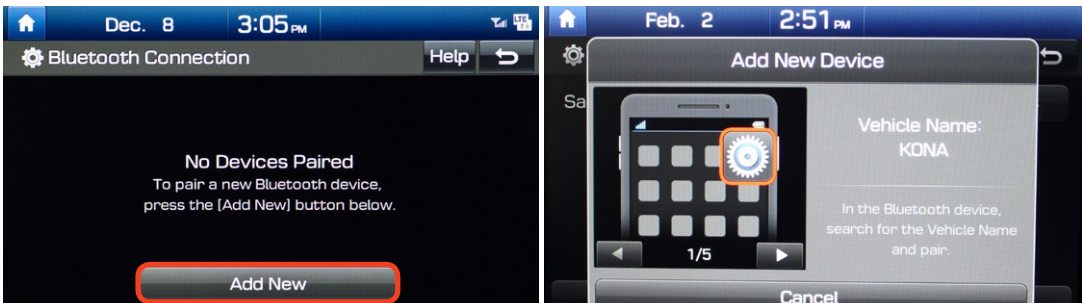
- 2 Press the **BLUETOOTH**® icon on the screen.

Then press **BLUETOOTH CONNECTION**.



- 3 Press **ADD NEW**.

Then turn on your phone's **BLUETOOTH** and select the device (Kona) found by your phone.



## NOTE

Bluetooth setting can be found in the SETTINGS app on most phones. Refer to your phone's owner's manual or visit [HyundaiBluetooth.com](http://HyundaiBluetooth.com) for more information.

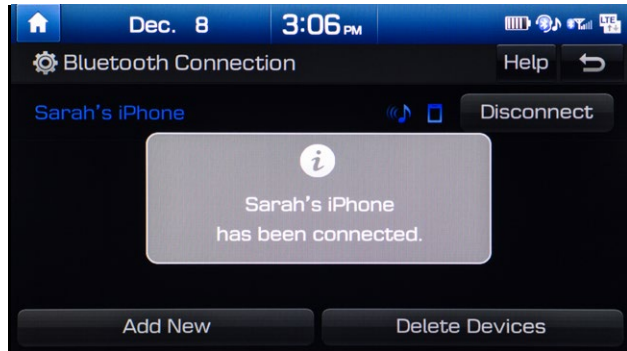

- 4 Your phone may require a **PASSKEY**. If prompted, enter it into your phone.



- 5 The vehicle will confirm successful phone pairing completion.



- 6 The vehicle will confirm that your contacts download is complete.



## NOTE

If your phone is supported, your contact list may be transferred to your vehicle automatically. Depending on the phone make and model:

- Some phones may request approval to download contacts; this process will take a few minutes
- Contact list may start with First or Last Name, depending on phone models

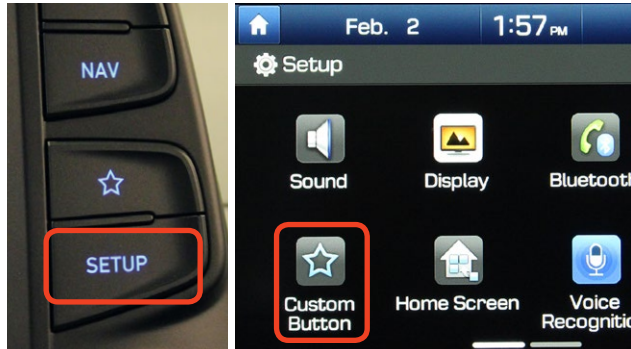
## CUSTOM BUTTON

The Custom Button (☆) is easy to set up and use so that you can enjoy your favorite features of the multimedia system with the touch of a button.

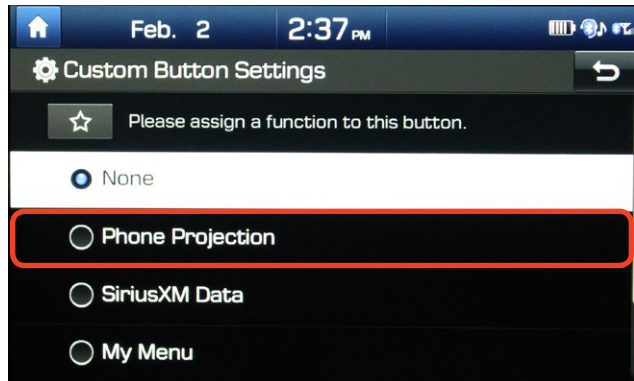
Learn how to set up your Custom Button by reviewing the steps below.

- 1 Press the **SETUP** button.

Then press the **CUSTOM BUTTON** icon on the screen.



- 2 Select from the following options to set as your favorites. For example, select **PHONE PROJECTION**.

## BEFORE YOU START

Make sure your phone has been paired and your contacts have been downloaded. If this has not been done, please follow the instructions on the previous pages.

- 1 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.

You will hear a beep.



- 2 After the beep, say the command "**CALL**" followed by the name of the desired contact.

Example:

"**CALL JOHN SMITH**"



- 3 Select the number you would like to call by saying

"**LINE 1,**" "**LINE 2,**"

"**WORK,**" or "**HOME.**"

# Making a Call

- The selected number will be dialed and your contact's name and phone number will appear on the screen.



- Press the **END CALL** button on the steering wheel to end the call.

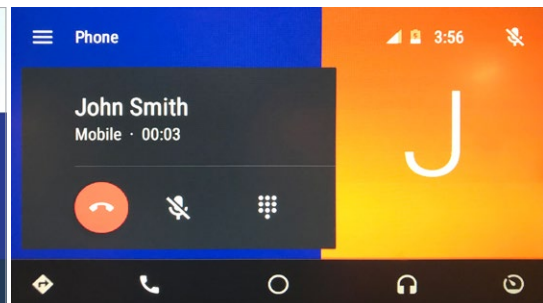
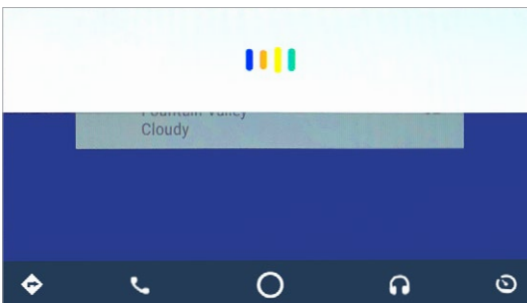
- 2 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel and say a command after the beep.



- 3 For Apple CarPlay, you will see these screens:

# Making a Call

Common Phone Voice Commands\*

Navigation

To start voice command, press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.

**HELP** provides guidance on commands that can be used within the current function.



**Here are a few common voice commands to use after the phone has been paired:**

Say “**CALL**” to initiate a call followed by saying the name of the saved contact with whom you wish to speak. For example, “**CALL JOHN SMITH.**”

“**DIAL**” makes a call by dialing the spoken numbers. For example: “**DIAL 1-800-633-5151.**”

“**PHONE**” provides guidance on phone-related commands.

“**CALL HISTORY**” displays the phone’s call history screen.

“**CONTACTS**” displays the phone’s contacts screen.

## NOTE

Compatibility and performance may vary based on your phone, the phone’s software, and your wireless carrier.

# Navigation

Destination Voice Command



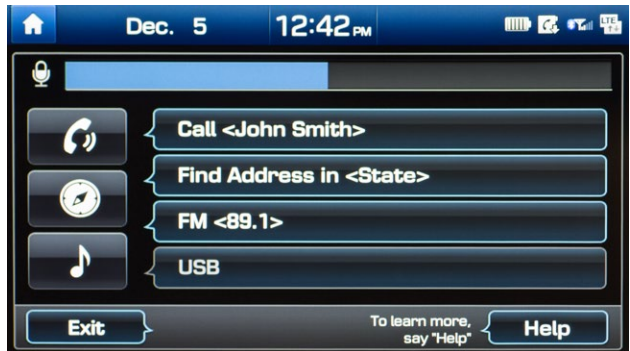

- 1 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.  
You will hear a beep.



- 2 After the beep, say a command: **"FIND POI\*\*."**

\*\*Point of Interest



- 3 This step will display the list of POI categories that you can say.

Say **"RESTAURANTS."**



- 4 A list of POI categories will be displayed. If you would like to find coffee shops nearby, say **"COFFEE SHOPS."**

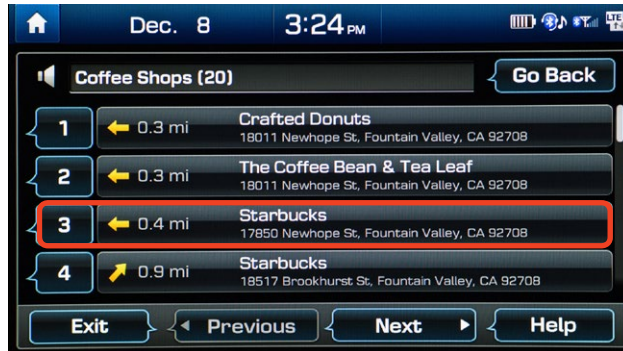
Destination Voice Command

- 5 The results will be listed on the screen.

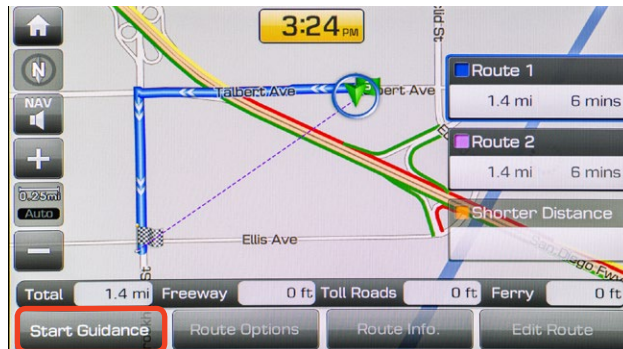
Say the line item number (for example: “**LINE 3**”) to make your selection.



- 6 Follow the prompt and say “**YES**” to set as your destination.



- 7 Route guidance will begin when you select **START GUIDANCE**.



- 8 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button and say “**CANCEL ROUTE**” after the prompt to stop navigation guidance.



# Navigation

Go to Address

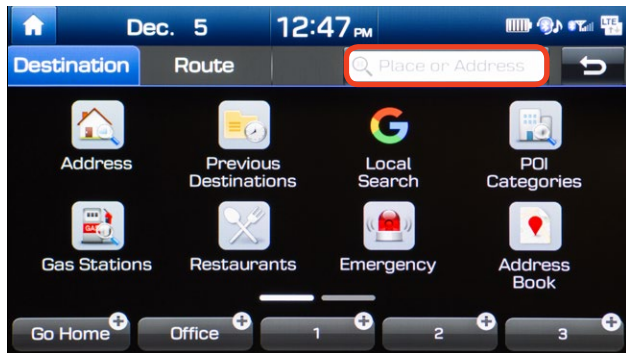

- 1 The vehicle must be in **PARK**.  
Press the **NAV** button.



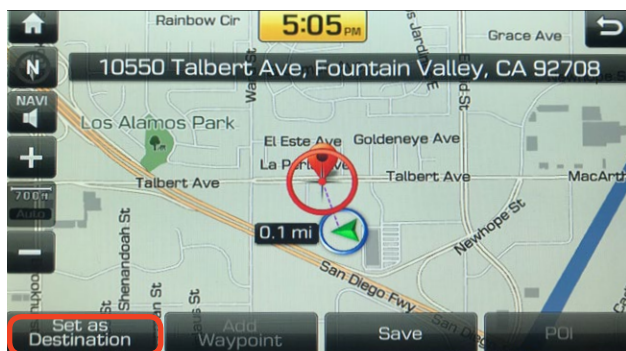
- 2 Touch the **UNIFIED SEARCH** box.



- 3 Enter the address of your destination and press **DONE**.



- 4 The location will be pinned on the map.  
If the address is correct, press **SET AS DESTINATION**.



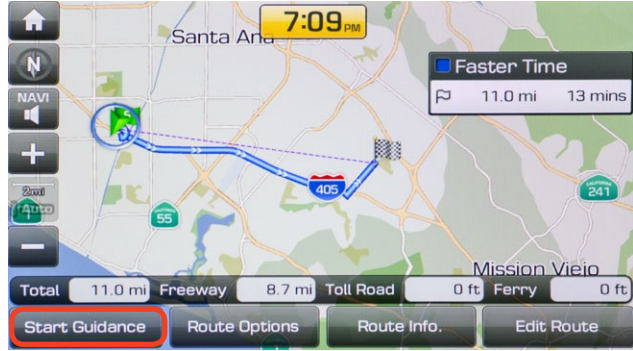

- 5 Press **START GUIDANCE** to begin your route.



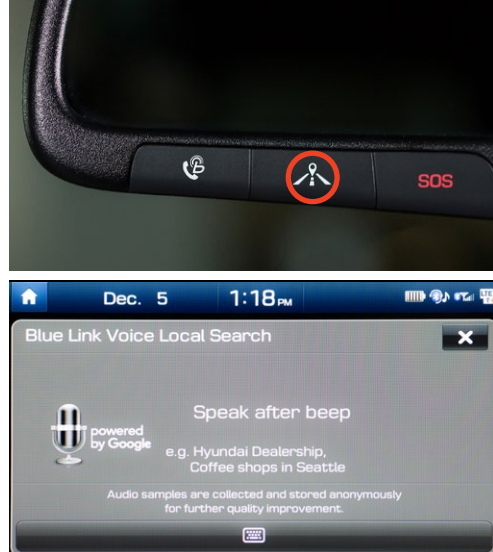
- 6 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button and say "**CANCEL ROUTE**" after the prompt to stop navigation guidance.



**1** Press the **DESTINATION SEARCH** button.

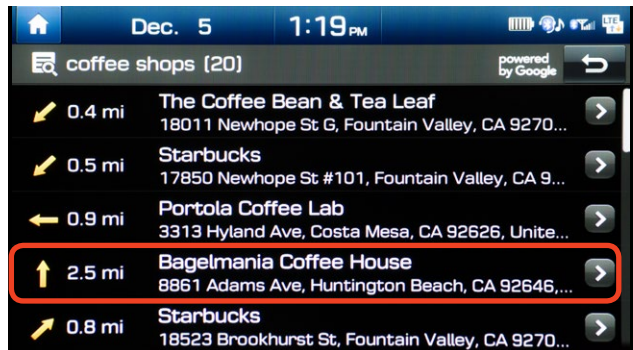
When prompted, you can say the name of a Point of Interest nearby, an address, or a Point of Interest in a city.

Example: **“FIND COFFEE SHOPS NEAR ME.”**

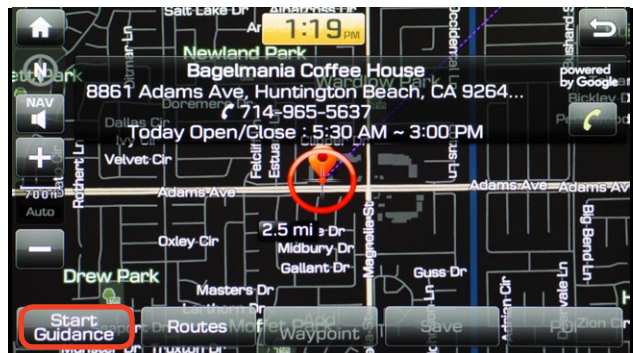


**2** A list of nearby destinations matching your search criteria will be displayed.

Select a destination from the list for a map view.



**3** Press **START GUIDANCE** to begin your route.
