- 1 Connect a USB cable from your phone to the vehicle's USB slot.

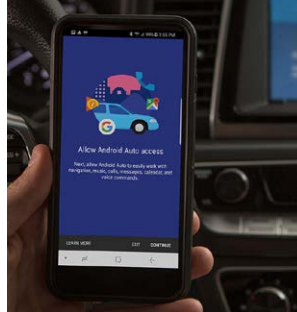

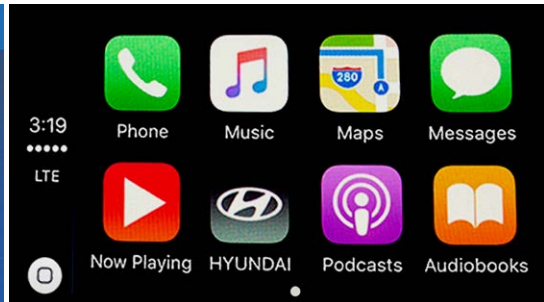


- 3 Enjoy using the applications displayed on your vehicle's multimedia screen.

# Phone Pairing

- 1 The vehicle's shifter must be in **PARK**.

Then press the **SETUP** button.



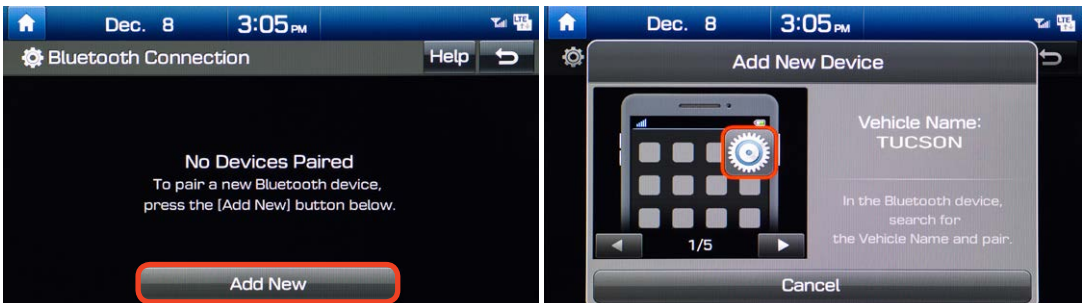
- 2 Press the **BLUETOOTH**® icon on the screen.

Then press **BLUETOOTH CONNECTION**.



- 3 Press **ADD NEW**.

Then turn on your phone's **BLUETOOTH** and select the device (Tucson) found by your phone.

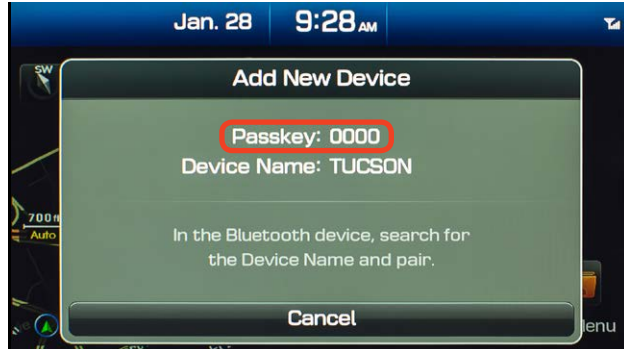

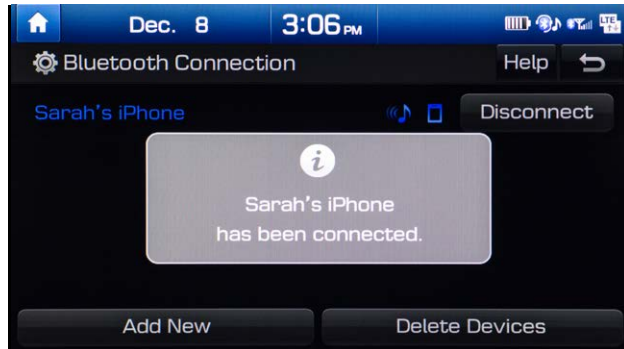

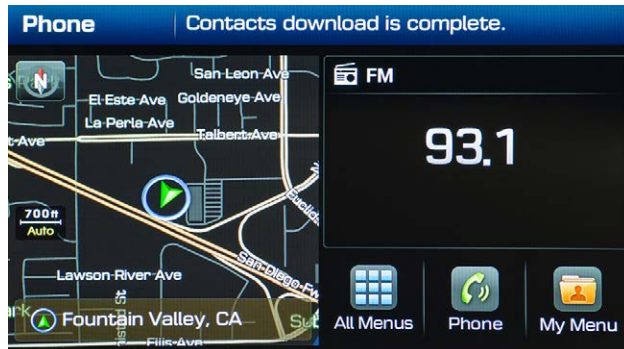
- 4 Your phone may require a **PASSKEY**. If prompted, enter it into your phone.



- 5 The vehicle will confirm successful phone pairing completion.



- 6 The vehicle will confirm that your contacts download is complete.



## NOTE

If your phone is supported, your contact list may be transferred to your vehicle automatically. Depending on the phone make and model:

- Some phones may request approval to download contacts; this process will take a few minutes
- Contact list may start with First or Last Name, depending on phone models

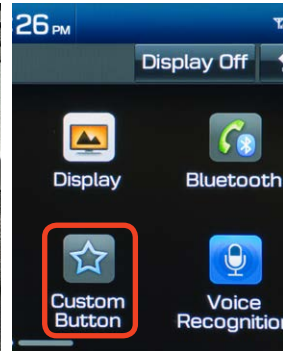
## CUSTOM BUTTON (if equipped)

The Custom Button (☆) is easy to set up and use so that you can enjoy your favorite features of the multimedia system with the touch of a button.

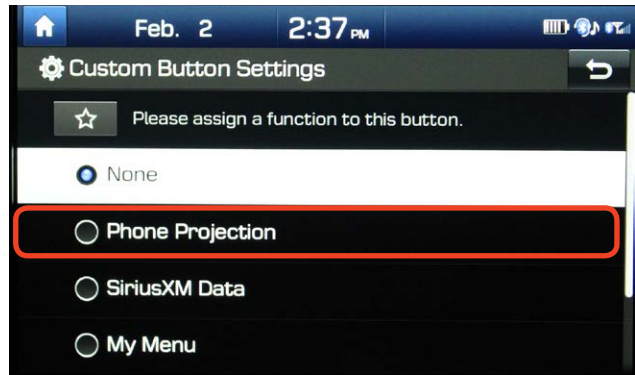
Learn how to set up your Custom Button by reviewing the steps below.

- 1 Press the **SETUP** button.

Then press the **CUSTOM BUTTON** icon on the screen.



- 2 Select from the following options to set as your favorites. For example, select **PHONE PROJECTION**.



# Making a Call

## BEFORE YOU START

Make sure your phone has been paired and your contacts have been downloaded to the vehicle. If this has not been done, please follow the instructions on the previous pages.

- 1 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.

You will hear a beep.



- 2 After the beep, say the command "**CALL**" followed by the name of the desired contact.

Example:

"**CALL JOHN SMITH**"



- 3 Select the number you would like to call by saying

"**LINE 1**," "**LINE 2**,"

"**HOME**," or "**MOBILE**."

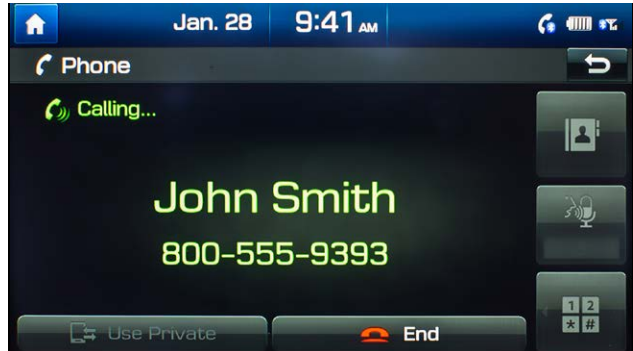

- 4 The selected number will be dialed and your contact's name and phone number will appear on the screen.



- 5 To end the call, press the **END CALL** button on the steering wheel.

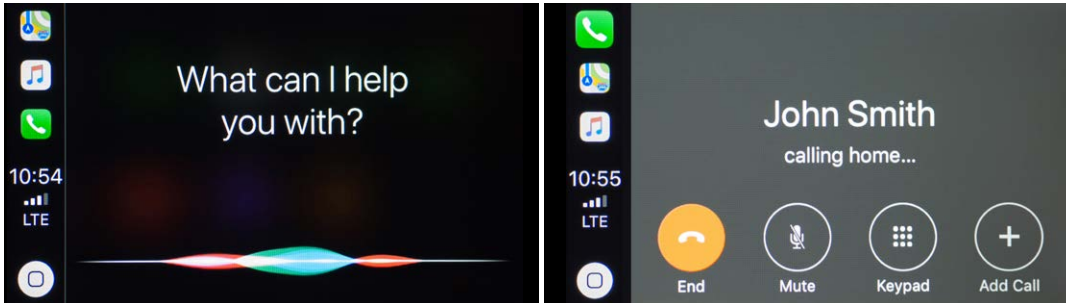

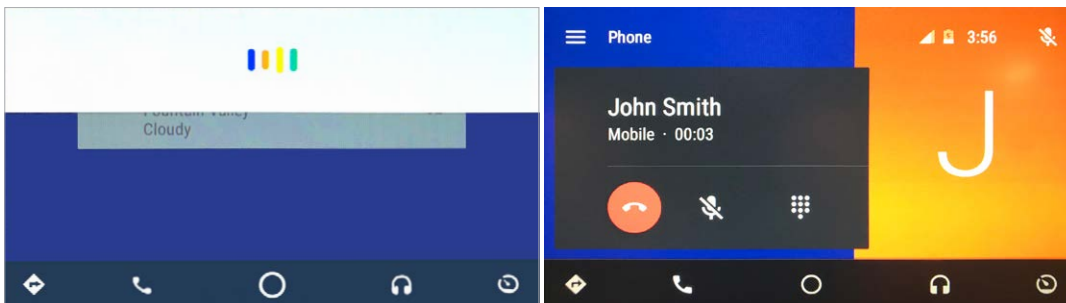
- 2 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel and say a command after the beep.



- 3 For Apple CarPlay, you will see these screens:

# Making a Call

Common Phone Voice Commands

To start voice command, press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.

**HELP** provides guidance on commands that can be used within the current function.



Here are a few common voice commands to use after the phone has been paired:

Say “**CALL**” to initiate a call followed by saying the name of the saved contact with whom you wish to speak.

For example, “**CALL JOHN SMITH.**”

“**DIAL**” makes a call by dialing the spoken numbers.

For example: “**DIAL 1-800-633-5151.**”

“**PHONE**” provides guidance on phone-related commands.

“**CALL HISTORY**” displays the phone’s call history screen.

“**CONTACTS**” displays the phone’s contacts screen.

## NOTE

Compatibility and performance may vary based on your phone, the phone's software, and your wireless carrier.

# Navigation

Destination Voice Command

Navigation

- 1 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button on the steering wheel.  
You will hear a beep.



- 2 After the beep, say a command:  
“**FIND POI\***.”

\*Point of Interest



- 3 This step will display the list of POI categories that you can say.

Say “**RESTAURANTS.**”



- 4 A list of POI categories will be displayed. If you would like to find coffee shops nearby, say “**COFFEE SHOPS.**”

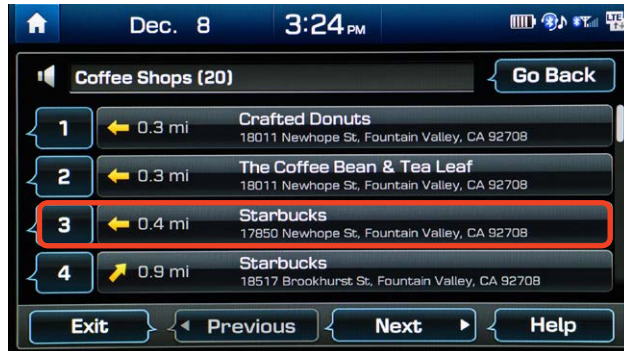

5 The results will be listed on the screen.

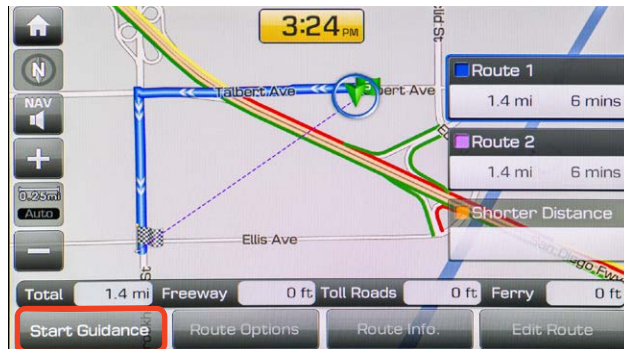
Say the line item number (for example: “**LINE 3**”) to make your selection.



6 Follow the prompt and say “**YES**” to set as your destination.



7 Route guidance will begin when you select **START GUIDANCE**.



8 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button and say “**CANCEL ROUTE**” after the prompt to stop navigation guidance.

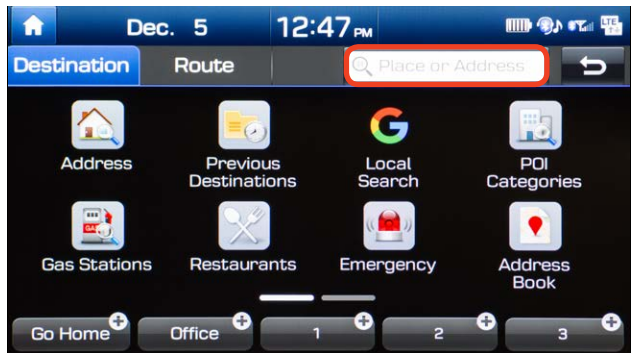

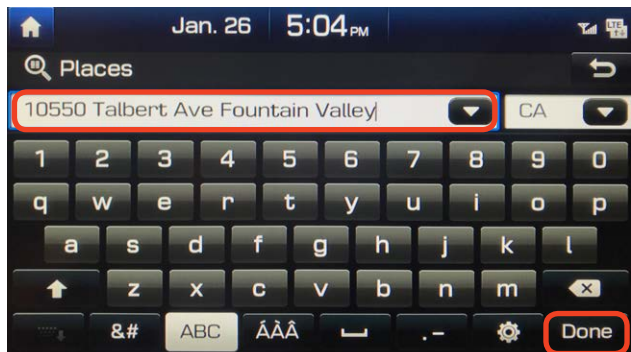
- 1 The vehicle must be in **PARK**.  
Press **NAVI** button.



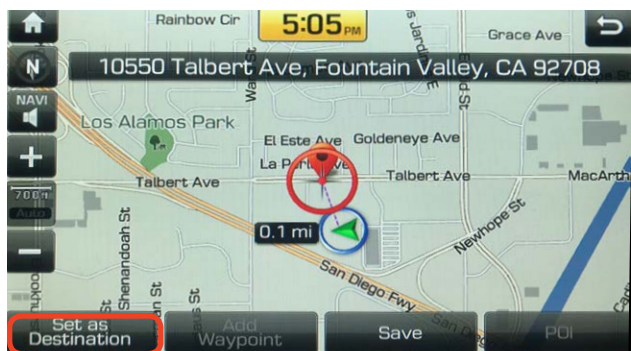
- 2 Touch the **UNIFIED SEARCH** box.



- 3 Enter the address of your destination and press **DONE**.



- 4 The location will be pinned on the map.  
If the address is correct, press **SET AS DESTINATION**.



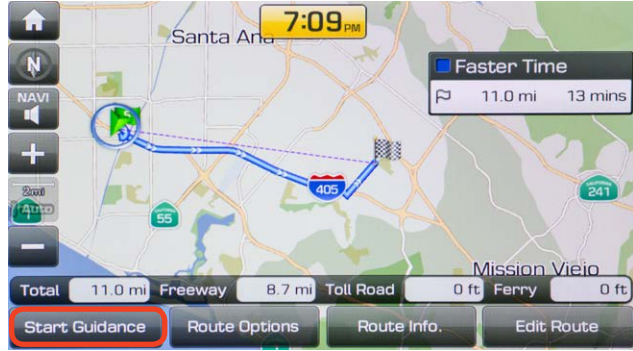

- 5 Press **START GUIDANCE** to begin your route.



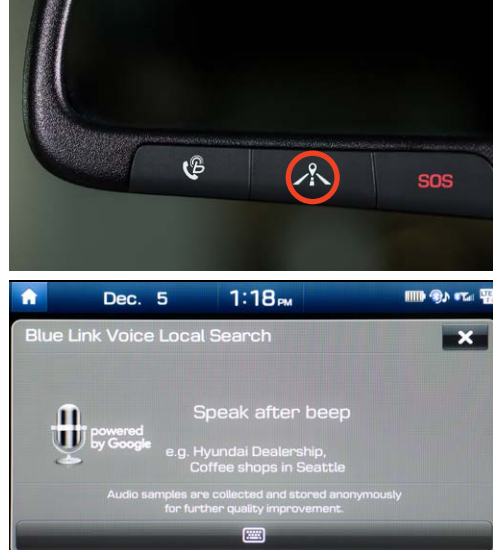
- 6 Press the **PUSH TO TALK** button and say "**CANCEL ROUTE**" after the prompt to stop navigation guidance.



**1** Press the **DESTINATION SEARCH** button.

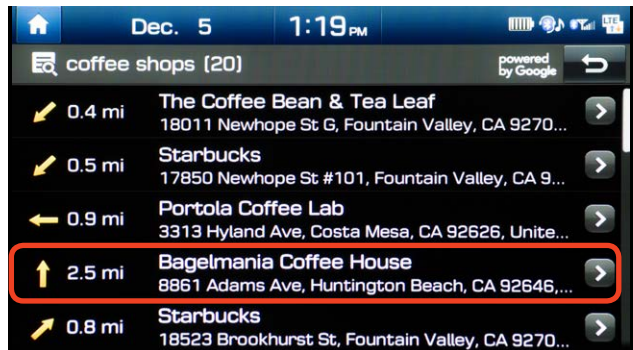
When prompted, you can say the name of a Point of Interest nearby, an address, or a Point of Interest in a city.

Example: **“FIND COFFEE SHOPS NEAR ME.”**

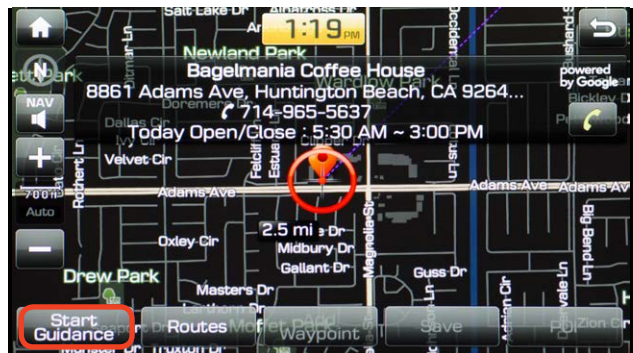


**2** A list of nearby destinations matching your search criteria will be displayed.

Select a destination from the list for a map view.



**3** Press **START GUIDANCE** to begin your route.
